

# COVID

As we near the 2021 Great Lakes' Regional Convention, please note the following guidelines for all attendees in the current climate of COVID-19:

- All attendees are responsible for their own health issues. Every attendee assumes all risk.
- Individuals who may be experiencing COVID or COVID-like symptoms should not attend the convention, considering one another and preferring one another in the light of our Lord's direction to love one another as yourself, doing unto others as you would have them do unto you (Mark 12:31; Luke 10:27).
- Attendees who are fully vaccinated may elect to not wear masks; however, any attendee may wear a mask if that is one's preference.
- Attendees who are not vaccinated are encouraged to wear masks.
- All attendees should use hand sanitizer often and engage in healthy hygienic practices.
- The convention staff is not encouraging traditional greetings of handshaking or familial-like embraces.
- Due to the limited space, social distancing will be a challenge. Every attendee will be responsible for his/her own comfortability as it relates to social distancing.
- Due to limited space and the rise of the Delta variant, especially in minors, no children's sessions will convene, as is customary during Regional Convention.
- In the event that the CDC recommends additional safety measures, Conference Attendee agrees to utilize such safety measures upon verbal or written request of Great Lakes Ministries-COGOP.
